1783

Bradbury Fabrics was founded in Huddersfield, UK, originally making blankets, rugs, and clothing, then later specialising in the contract sector. Camira acquired the business in 2012.

1822

John Holdsworth & Co. was founded in Halifax. The company grew to become a leading global transport textile manufacturer, with clients including The Orient Express and Transport for London. Camira acquired the business in 2007.

1987

Camborne took control of its own fabric manufacturing at Hopton Mills, Mirfield – prior to this, fabrics were commission woven.

1997

Camborne was acquired by US carpet tile company Interface, Inc and rebranded to Interface Fabrics.

2000

Manufacturing moved to Meltham Mills, Huddersfield. Interface Fabrics acquired technical knitting business, Teknit, now known as Camira Knit.

2003

Interface Fabrics acquired British Furtex Fabrics, a manufacturer of transport fabrics.

2012

Camira set up Park Valley Dyers, a state-of-the-art yarn dyeing facility.

2019

Camira acquired Holmfirth Dyers, extending its vertical manufacturing integration to piece-dyeing fabrics and specialist finishing. We also acquired US textile brand Luna, originally founded by industry icon Anna Hernandez.

1863

Stork Brothers was founded in Huddersfield, supplying woollen spun yarns for hosiery, then apparel, hand knitting and woollen upholstery. Camira acquired the business in 2013 and it is now known as Camira Yarns.

1974

Camborne was founded in Huddersfield, UK – the forerunner to Camira.

1998

Interface Fabrics launched its first 100% recycled polyester fabrics. ReSKU – a fabric made from recycled army jumpers – was also released in this year.

2006

Camira was borne following a management buy-out from Camborne.

2008

Camira launched Sting – an industry-first environmental fabric, made from wool blended with nettles. This development led to the innovation of a new category of fabrics made from plant stem fibres, including hemp and flax.

2020

Oceanic was launched – a fabric made from recycled marine plastic, it was joined in 2021 by Quest. Created in partnership with the SEAQUAL Initiative, an ocean clean-up organisation combatting marine plastic pollution.

2022

Camira acquired iinouilio – a leader in wool recycling, breaking new ground in textile circularity.

When it comes to recycling, we've been doing our bit for a long time now. But in 2022, we made the decision to do more.

We bought a textile recycling capability called iinouiiio, meaning "it is never over until it is over." This gives us the skill, expertise and know-how to take textile circularity to a new level. With iinouiiio, wool textiles and worn clothing can have a new lease of life. They can be pulled back to fibre, blended, spun, and made to be used again - as fabric, on furniture or for fashion.

We've never liked to see things go to waste. Now, we'll see even less of it.
