<u>Information Requested</u>: Please see below for a clarification from Camira Fabrics and Chief Engineer of the Vehicle Certification Agency about the UN Regulation 118 regarding Camira Transport Fabric Ltd.

The difference between Reg 118.00 and Reg 118.01 is the addition of Annex 9 which is not applicable for our fabrics, therefore;

VCA: "There is no difference between Reg 118.00 and Reg 118.01 for the purpose of Camira Fabric Ltd's approvals as both entail compliance to Annex 6 and 7, if stated on the approval paperwork".

The difference between Reg 118.**02** and Reg 118.**03** is the addition of Annex 10 which is <u>not applicable for our fabrics</u>, therefore;

VCA: "There is no difference between Reg 118.02 and Reg 118.03 for the purpose of Camira Transport Fabric Ltd's approvals as both entail compliance to Annex 7 and 8, if stated on the approval paperwork".

The difference between Reg 118.01 and Reg 118.02 is a change to under what conditions Annexes 6 and 8 need testing. This is significant to approvals of our fabrics.

VCA: "Annex 6 covers the requirements for horizontal burn rate, Annex 7 for the melting behaviour and Annex 8 for the vertical burn rate. Materials installed more than 15 degrees from the horizontal are covered by Annex 8 test requirements, rather than Annex 6 test requirements".

<u>Also Note</u>: As our fabrics are not used in engine compartments or adjacent to electrical cables Annexes 9 and 10, and therefore the regulation updates parts 1 and 3, do not impact our approvals.
